MEMBER TICKETS

Each adult member of TBE is entitled to one ticket. Children ages 8-26 will receive tickets at no charge. You must include your children's names and ages with your ticket order. Tickets will be provided only to members in good standing. "In good standing" means that at least 1/3 of your 2011-2012 Temple membership obligations and any past-due balances have been paid prior to the High Holy Days.

SERVICE LOCATIONS

Temple Beth El holds services simultaneously at the Carole and Barry Kaye Auditorium at Florida Atlantic University and in the Rabbi Merle E. Singer Sanctuary at Temple Beth El's main campus.

- Members may choose to celebrate services either at FAU or at Temple Beth El.
- Guests who are not members of Temple Beth El must attend services at FAU.
- Members and Guests who choose to participate in our new Learners Service on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur morning will celebrate services in the Frances and Solon Cohen Atrium at Temple Beth El. Only those with a TBE ticket will be admitted to the Rabbi Merle E. Singer Sanctuary.
- All services for Rosh Hashanah evening take place at Temple Beth El.

TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Bus transportation will ONLY be running on Rosh Hashanah, Thursday, September 29th at FAU. On that Thursday please enter the campus at NW 13th Street/Florida Atlantic Boulevard off of Glades Road and follow the direction signs to Parking Lot 5A. Buses will run an hour before and an hour after services taking you back and forth between the lot and auditorium. Please allow ample time for this shuttle service. Parking in student or faculty designated spots during school hours may result in a parking ticket.

PURCHASING MEMBER GUEST TICKETS \$150 EACH

We welcome your family and friends to High Holy Day services. Guest tickets are \$150/person for the entire holiday, or \$75 for each holiday. Due to space considerations, guest tickets are for FAU services only, except for Erev Rosh Hashanah or for our new Learners Service when we celebrate together at Temple Beth El.

SERVICES FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH

This year for the High Holy Days, children and youth services will be divided into different age groups each with their own special service.*

HIGH HOLY **Tots**

LEARNERS SERVICE

Our new High Holy Days Learners Services, which will be held on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur mornings in addition to our regular traditional services, will help us discover why we do and what we do.

Led by Rabbis Brockman and Mandel with Cantorial Soloist Scott Gates, these services will be infused with knowledge, teaching and spirituality.

Those who choose to attend the Learners Service will be issued a special pass in addition to your regular High Holy Day ticket. Learners services on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur are offered as a simultaneous alternative to the morning services at FAU and in the Rabbi Merle E. Singer Sanctuary, and will provide a beautiful prayer experience.

For those who request or buy guest tickets (\$150) for these services they will be held in the Frances and Solon Cohen Atrium at the same time as our traditional Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur morning services taking place in the Rabbi Merle E. Singer Sanctuary at Temple Beth El for our members.

Tickets must be requested for the Learners Services. Seating is limited.

High Holy Days Youth Program Grades K-5

For our members, we've designed our High Holy Days Youth Program to give your kindergarten-fifth grade students an opportunity to participate in an enriching, hands-on experience while parents are praying in the morning worship service in the Merle E. Singer Sanctuary. This exciting program is offered **at Temple Beth El only**, and will start at 10:00 AM and finish simultaneously to the adult morning worship service on the first day of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Children will participate in art projects, stories, song-sessions, snacks, and Tefillah. This program is not meant to replace the Children's or Youth Services, but it is an additional experience that will allow parents to attend the adult worship services at the Temple. Reservation forms must be received by **August 26** to ensure proper staffing and group placements. There is a \$5.00 charge per child per holiday experience. Students will be grouped by age. Siblings will not be in the same group unless they are in the same grade level at school.

Complimentary Babysitting Ages 2-7

Babysitting services are available at **Temple Beth El and FAU**. Reservation forms must be received by **August 26** to ensure proper staffing.



This program is available for children in kindergarten through grade five who are members of Temple Beth El.
