## MEMBER TICKETS

Each adult member of TBE is entitled to one ticket. Children ages 8-26 will receive tickets at no charge. You must include your children's names and ages with your ticket order. Tickets will be provided only to members in good standing. "In good standing" means that at least 1/3 of your 2010-2011 Temple membership obligations and any past-due balances have been paid prior to the High Holy Days.

## SERVICE LOCATIONS

The location you choose is the one at which you will attend all services.

**Members** -TBE Members may attend services at either Temple Beth El or FAU.

**Members with Guests** - TBE Members with guests must attend services at FAU.

## TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Bus transportation will ONLY be running on Rosh Hashanah, Thursday, September 9th at FAU. On that Thursday please enter the campus at NW 13th Street/Florida Atlantic Boulevard off of Glades Road and follow the direction signs to the designated parking lot. Buses will run an hour before and an hour after services taking you back and forth between the lot and auditorium. Please allow ample time for this shuttle service. Parking in student or faculty designated spots during school hours may result in a parking ticket.

## PURCHASING MEMBER GUEST TICKETS \$150 EACH.

We welcome your family and friends to High Holy Day services. Guest tickets are \$150/person for the entire holiday, or \$75 for each holiday. Due to space considerations, guest tickets are for FAU services only, except for Erev Rosh Hashanah when we celebrate together at Temple Beth El.

## CHILDREN AND YOUTH SERVICES

### Children Services

These services are geared toward families with children from birth through grade three. They are upbeat and age-appropriate, while communicating the main messages of the High Holy Days.

### Youth Services

Youth Services are geared toward families with children in grades four and up. They are held in a less formal environment and feature participation by TBE's youth groups in an atmosphere of celebration and song.

*All tickets, regardless of location, are valid at all Children and Youth services.*

## HIGH HOLY DAYS YOUTH PROGRAM \$5/CHILD/PROGRAM

This program is for members only and will start and end simultaneously to the adult morning worship services on the first day of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. It is designed to give children a hands-on experience to include art projects, stories, singing, snacks and Tefilah. This program does not replace the Children or Youth Services, but is an additional program to enhance your child's celebration of the High Holy Days.

## BABYSITTING

Temple Beth El provides complimentary childcare for children ages 2 through 7 during all High Holy Day services at TBE and FAU.

# High Holy Days Information for Children and Youth

## High Holy Days Youth Program

For our members, we've designed our High Holy Days Youth Program to give your kindergarten-fifth grade students an opportunity to participate in an enriching, hands-on experience. This exciting program is offered **at Temple Beth El only**, and will start and finish simultaneously to the adult morning worship service on the first day of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Children will participate in art projects, stories, song-sessions, snacks, and Tefillah. This program is not meant to replace the Children's or Youth Services, but it is an additional experience that will allow parents to attend the adult worship services at the Temple. Reservation forms must be received by **August 6** to ensure proper staffing and group placements. There is a \$5.00 charge per child per holiday experience. Students will be grouped by age. Siblings will not be in the same group unless they are in the same grade level at school.

## Complimentary Babysitting

Babysitting services are available at **Temple Beth El and FAU**. Reservation forms must be received by **August 6** to ensure proper staffing.

## Children's and Youth Services

Each year, we create services especially for families with children.

**Children's Services** are geared toward families with children from birth through grade three. They're upbeat and age-appropriate, while communicating the main messages of the High Holy Days.

**Youth Services** are geared toward families with children in grades four and up. Also held in a less-formal environment, Youth Services feature participation by TBE's youth groups in an atmosphere of celebration and song.
